Listed below are some of the exciting things that have taken place at AHS over the last 12 weeks:



AHS PTA Scholarships

Attention Seniors and Parents of Seniors!!

To be eligible for a PTA scholarship this year the <u>senior student</u> and a parent MUST be a member of the Arlington High School PTA. You may join the AHS PTA at registration. Please don't wait until March when the scholarship applications are due to take care of this very important detail.

Texas PTA awarding \$1000 Scholarships

Texas PTA offers \$1000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors in Texas who will be enrolled full-time in an accredited college or university or a technical institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following the applicant's high school graduation.

The application is available online now and is <u>due by November 15th</u>. A requirement is that the student and one parent must be a member of the AHS PTA.

Counselor's Corner

We will start Dual Credit enrollment in January for next summer and the next school year! For Academic Dual Credit (U.S. History, English 4, Government, Economics, Psychology and Sociology) students must have a 7.0 GPA on our 12 point scale and must be at least a sophomore (going to enter their junior or senior year). The testing components for eligibility for academic dual credit classes are the Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA) and the TSI (Texas Success Initiative). The student will be required to attend one of the PAAs after school in the cafeteria January 29th and 30th. TSI test dates are 2/20, 3/5, and 3/26 in E hall computer labs. Only students who complete the PAA will be allowed in the testing room. Interested students should apply to TCC NOW! www.tccd.edu/apply (click on Dual Credit student)

Seniors - there are many dates available coming up to take the TSI. If you have not taken the TSI please scan the QR code found throughout the hallways to register for the pre-assessment activity (PAA). The go center will then contact you to help you complete the registration process. If you have not passed a particular section please see your counselor.

Parents - we had a very successful Red Ribbon Week campaign at AHS this October! Information on our activities can be found on our counseling webpage, and we want everyone to pay close attention to information we have on the various kinds of vaping and the dangers (and consequences) this can carry. Check the AHS counseling page for a link to more information.

Workforce Dual Credit and CTE Special Programs are available as well. Most of the programs need a 4.0/12.0 and you must be at least a sophomore. All CTE Special Programs & Workforce Dual Credit will use an online application. Check the aisd net student page for the online application (www.aisd.net/students/). All applications must be submitted by January 31st, 2018

Colt Trail Drive will be Thursday, January 16th from 7-8 pm. This event is for AHS's Class of 2024. If you are interested in learning about the different electives that are available and be able to talk to teachers/coaches before your 8th grade student has to make those decisions in their CTHEI class, join us in the Auditorium at AHS.

We will begin the registration process for sophomores and juniors for 2019-2020 classes starting in January of 2020. We will be using Career Cruising again this year. Students and parents are encouraged to review information at careercruising.com (username: ID# and password: 1st five letters of your last name plus your ID#) The program will be fully updated prior to the second semester. You can get to Career Cruising through the student page at aisd.net. Watch for more detailed information regarding our computer registration on the AHS Counselor website.

We are finishing up our 9th grade Personal Graduation Plan in November/December and want to thank all of our freshmen/freshmen parents for meeting with us!

All students - Remember that the semester ends before the holidays and good attendance up until December 19th is extremely important.
