#### Counselor's Corner

It's hard to believe that this school year is drawing to a close. Congratulations to the Class of 2019! We wish you all the best! Parents, mark your calendars for Senior Awards on Monday, May 20, at 7:00 p.m. in the auditorium. We look forward to celebrating the many accomplishments of your students.

Our returning students will receive a <u>listing of classes</u> in May that he or she selected for next year. If your student is requesting a change, please encourage him or her to stop by either of the counseling offices for a change form before the beginning of the new school year. This form can be filled out and left for the counselor.

AISD Summer School Regular and Accelerated sessions will be held June 10-June 28, and July 08-July 26. AHS classes for summer school will be held at Martin High School. Transportation will be available to Martin from AHS. Session One is Mon-Fri for Accelerated Classes & EOC Remediation - all day classes for one full credit (7:30-2:40). Students can earn original credit. Summer School Session Two will run Monday-Friday for Regular & Accelerated classes. Students can recover credit(s) OR earn original credit. There will be morning (sem. 1 courses) and afternoon (sem. 2 courses) classes. Times are 7:30-10:45 (a.m. classes) and 11:25-2:40 (p.m. classes.) Students may also take all day accelerated classes for one full credit in Session Two and the times are 7:30 a.m. – 2:40 p.m. More information can be found here - https://www.aisd.net/district/departments/academic-services/transformational-learning/summer-school/

Early registration for summer school will be May 15 – times TBD. Regular registration for Session One will be held on June 6 and June 7 from 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. Regular registration for Session Two will be held on June 27 and June 28 from 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. and payment will be due at that time. Listen to announcements for any information regarding possible early registration dates. To attend summer school, a student MUST have a registration form filled out by a counselor. The cost is \$75 per .5 semester credit and \$150 for one full credit. For more information contact your student's counselor.

For those students enrolled in Dual Credit Summer School, the dates are June 3-July 3 (M-TH) for session 1, and July 8-August 8 for session 2. Payments for dual credit summer school are \$59 per semester course. Payment for fall will be mid-May. Payment for Spring will be in December. Schedules for summer school will be distributed a couple of weeks before the end of the school year. Dual credit students registered for summer school as part of the application process completed earlier this spring.

EOC scores from the March and May administrations are due in district by June 2<sup>nd</sup>.

As students receive their end of year report card, please keep in mind Arlington ISD's policy for grade classification. To be classified as a senior, a student must have 18 credits. To be a junior, a student must have 12 credits and six credits are needed to be classified as a sophomore. Students are awarded .5 credit for each semester class they passed.

Boys 200 FR relays and 400 FR relays: **Anthony V., David M., Harrison M.,** and **Derick M.** advances to the Regional Meet.


Derick M., Harrison M., and Anthony V. qualified for individual events at Regional.
